

Town of Carson – Annual Meeting – April 16, 2024

Town of Carson Annual Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Chairman Wally Zywicki with all officers presents. Town residents in attendance were Dave & Dan Kieffer, Audrey Revling, Chris Sobczak, Roger Czerwony, Dale Brommelkamp, and Sam Worzalla. Also in attendance was town employee, Jim Lewandowski.

Minutes of the April 19, 2023, Annual meeting were read. Motion by Audrey Revling and seconded by Roger Czerwony to approve the meeting minutes. Passed unanimously.

Alex Jazdzewski reviewed the 2023 Annual Treasurer's Report and Annette Stashek presented the 2023 Annual Financial Report. Motion by Dale Brommelkamp and seconded by Roger Czerwony to accept the reports as presented. Passed unanimously.

Resident Audrey Revling expressed concern over excessive dust on Lone Elm Road and provided the Board with information regarding its health hazards. Dust control will be applied again this summer on designated roads within the township.

Wally Zywicki reported on the following road projects and equipment:

- Bluebird Bridge was not replaced in 2023. Work will be done in 2024.
- Work on Third Avenue Bridge will occur in 2025 or 2026 due to cost.
- The 6' to 20' Culvert program. Culverts/bridges will be identified in 2024 with possible aid received in late 2024 or in 2025 for repairs and/or replacements.
- Road resurfacing planned:
 - County Line Road was partially resurfaced in 2023 and should be finished in 2024.
 - Maple Road as needed.
 - Dead end roads have been neglected in the past and may receive some resurfacing in 2024.
- Slurry seal and micro sealing: Town is looking at Fahrner as a new contractor.
- Diamond boom mower and JD tractor to be delivered in early in 2024.
- Challenger tractor to be sold or traded in during 2024.

Supervisor Ken Zarecki reported that for 2023, there were 73 medical calls and 17 fire calls for a total of 90 calls handled by the Rudolph Fire Department. So far for 2024, there have been 21 medical calls and 2 fire calls for a total of 23.

There being no further business to discuss, a motion to adjourn was made by Roger Czerwony and seconded by Dale Brommelkamp. Passed unanimously.

The Annual Meeting was adjourned at 7:27 pm.
